11. **VIOGNIER**  
**SANTA ROSA, ARGENTINA 2008** £18.75  
Full of tropical fruit flavours, with aromas of peach, apple, pear and damson, Has a good structure with a dry, well rounded finish.
12. **SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
**ALPHA DOMUS, HAWKES BAY NEW ZEALAND 2008** £26.75  
Aromas of pear, passion fruit and citrus zest A crisp palate with lime, passion fruit and riper tropical fruit flavours.
13. **CHABLIS** £29.95  
**DOMAINE D'ELISE, BURGUNDY FRANCE 2007**  
In 1982 Frédéric Prain took over this Domaine which is fabulously situated on the upper slopes of the hillside above Premier Cru Côte de Lechet.
